- And to act as pioneers and leaders in the Church's reconciling work in the world.

Bishop: Angie, do you promise faithfully to fulfill your ministry among this people through preaching and teaching the word of God?

Minister: I do solemnly promise.

Bishop: Do you promise faithfully to administer the sacraments of the church?

Minister: I do solemnly promise.

Bishop: Do promise to faithfully minister to those who are sick and troubled?

Minister: I do solemnly promise.

Bishop: Do you promise faithfully to share in leadership to strengthen the church's life?

Minister: I do solemnly promise.

Bishop: Do you promise faithfully to represent in a worthy manner what it means to live in faithful response to God's abiding grace?

Minister: I do solemnly promise.

The congregation will stand.

CHARGE TO THE CONGREGATION

Bishop: Will you who witness this new beginning support and uphold Angie, praying daily for her life and ministry among you?

People: We will.

Bishop: Having called Angie to be your minister, do you renew your baptismal vows and commit yourself to supporting her with your prayers and shared responsibilities?

People: We reaffirm our baptism and our commitment to Jesus the Christ and our loyalty to Christ's church. We covenant to uphold our pastor with our prayers; to share her joys and sorrows; to attend to her preaching and teaching of God's word; to welcome her pastoral care; and honor her leadership.

Minister: Standing with you, I promise to be your pastor; and in the strength and grace of Jesus Christ I covenant to serve this congregation in all faithfulness for the Glory of God.

AFFIRMATION OF COMMON FAITH

Regional Elder: Let us unite in affirming our common faith. Please join in the reading of the Preamble of the Design of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ):

As members of the Christian Church, We confess that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, and proclaim him Lord and Savior of the world. In Christ's name and by his grace we accept our mission of witness

and service to all people. We rejoice in God, maker of heaven and earth, and in God's covenant of love which binds us to God and to one another. Through baptism into Christ we enter into newness of life and are made one with the whole people of God. In the communion of the Holy Spirit we are joined together in discipleship and in obedience to Christ. At the Table of the Lord we celebrate with thanksgiving the saving acts and presence of Christ. Within the universal church, we receive the gift of ministry and the light of scripture. In the bonds of Christian faith we yield ourselves to God that we may serve the One whose kingdom has no end. Blessing, glory, and honor be to God forever. Amen.

If you send cards on a regular basis, this is a great option for you and a money saver, as well. Each box has 12 cards. At \$7.00 per box, that makes each card less than .60, a big savings from what you'd pay in a card shop or department store on individual cards. Cards may be purchased from any member of the CWF. Money can be given to Michelle Walker or the church office.
